From January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014 the alternative energy systems on the Yuut Elitnaurviat campus produced **49,551** kWh of electricity! Although this is down 5,180 kWh from 2013, it is still an estimated cost savings of **\$27.253.05** (based on an average cost of \$0.55/kWh).



## Certified Nurse's Assistant (CNA); Jan. 26 - Mar. 6, 2015

Flights, meals, lodging, course fees, and all test fees will be paid for through the GED Works Program. **Students will only be accepted based on** the recommendation of the Bethel Regional ABE Program, clean criminal history, AND a letter of intent to hire by a local employer.

## **GED Works Driver Training - By Appointment**

The GED Works program will pay for <u>current GED students</u>, or <u>people who graduated</u> <u>with their GED after July 1, 2012</u> to travel to Bethel and spend a week learning how to drive through the Yuut Driving Academy. Up to eight (8) behind-the-wheel lessons and a Road Test are included, as are flight meals and lodging. **Students will only be accepted based on the recommendation of the Bethel Regional ABE Program, clean criminal history, AND a letter of intent to hire by a local employer.**
