Class A CDL Training

Becoming certified by the Professional Truck Driver Institute (PTDI) has been the culmination of two years of hard work by Lead Driving Instructor Gerry Graves. Being certified allows the Yuut Driving Academy to be formally approved by the State of Alaska to teach Commercial Driving. In the future this should also allow our students to take out State Education Loans or use the Montgomery G.I. Bill to pay for the program.

GED Works RFMT 100 Training

Yuut Elitnaurviat held a ten day Rural Facility Maintenance Technician (RFMT) 100 training this quarter for students who qualified under the GED Works grant. David Chief of Bethel, Alex Gregory of Chefornak, Luke Isaac of Bethel, and Teddy Moses of Toksook Bay completed the training and earned their NCCER Core cards. The training also counts for credit at both AVTEC in Seward and at UAF.

GED Works Driver Education

Students who have received their HS Diploma after May 2012 or their GED after July 2012 qualify for free Driving Lessons and Road Tests under Yuut Elitnaurviat's GED Works Grant. Having a Driver License is a huge asset when looking for a job in the YK Delta. Thirty five people took advantage of this during this quarter and used it to get their Alaska Learners Permits and Alaska Driver Licenses.


Upcoming Driver Training
