LPN Program Manager/Instructor

The LPN Program Manager works with the Programs Director to develop a Licensed Practical Nursing program for Yuut Elitnaurviat and deliver the program instruction of the program.

Salary: \$80,000 - \$100,000 DOE + Benefits; Approximately 200 days/year

Responsibilities:

- * Assists in the development of the LPN program based on Alaska Board of Nursing and Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education guidelines
- * Once provisional approval for the program has been obtained from the Alaska Board of Nursing, assists in obtaining and maintaining national accreditation
- * Ability to plan, prepare, and teach course content and curriculum utilizing assessment and effective methodologies of instruction for the enhancement of learning
- * Maintains expertise in field of study and responsibilities and their performance reflects scholarship and evidence-based teaching in clinical practices
- * Assigns, guides, supervises, and evaluates student performance in giving care to selected patients/residents.
- * Demonstrates procedures in nursing skills laboratory, supervise student demonstrations, and evaluate student performances
- * Orients students to the clinical site and communicates clinical objectives to the student and the staff
- * Other duties as assigned

Required Qualifications:

- * **Must be a Registered nurse who is currently licensed in Alaska and who has at least a master's degree in nursing and preparation or experience in administration, education, and a minimum of one year of experience in clinical nursing practice (State requirement based on 12 AAC 44.060)**
- * Valid Alaska Driver License with clean driving record and ability to pass a background check
- * Computer literacy and the ability to enter data and complete reporting
- * Must be able to work and communicate with other members of the YE Team as well as the Alaska Board of Nursing and clinical site administrators
- * Must be willing to comply with all company policies and procedures, especially with regard to safety
- * Ability to work independently and with confidentiality
- * Possess strong communication skills
- * Ability to plan and initiate educational programs
- * Experience in working in a cross-cultural setting
- * Yup'ik speaker preferred
